



## **Psychological Associate**

### **Qualifications:**

The successful candidate must have a MA Associate in Clinical Psychology and be fully registered for autonomous practice with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. Computer literacy is essential for purposes of electronic charting, particularly the ability to use Microsoft Office. The successful candidate must be highly organized, have exceptional written and communication skills and the ability to work independently.
