Position Summary:

We are seeking to fill a part-time, permanent position of Evening and Weekend Nurse.

- Insure the safety and well-being of residents, assesses, and guests during evening and weekends through the provision of primary nursing care including CPR, suicide prevention, crisis management, and necessary dispensation of medication.
- Proactively attend to signs and symptoms of inordinate distress or illness on the part of residents and determine appropriate intervention.
- Inform the clinical treatment team of any clinically relevant events occurring outside of regular clinical hours through notation in the electronic nursing log.
- Identify need for intervention by on-call staff member and notify and apprise on-call staff member in a timely and effective manner.
- Update comprehensive medication list.
- Provide initial intake screening and orientation of assesses and residents.
- Conduct Comprehensive Health Assessment on assesses and direct-admit residents.
- Serve as weekday nurse for the Institute and assume duties of Nursing Team Leader when needed at the discretion of the Nursing Team Leader.
- Engage in ongoing professional development consistent with the identified priorities of the Institute.
- Observe all policies and procedures of the Institute promoting safety for residents, assesses, guests, and staff.
